Qualifications

- Minimum of a Bachelor's Degree in education, special education or related student services field
- Experience working with children with learning needs
- Able to effectively learn and use Google Classroom/Suite
- Able to collect objective data, calculate it, and present it graphically
- Able to work collaboratively with teachers, parents and supervisors
- Able to administer informal and formal assessment measures, document results, and share areas of concern with teachers and Student Support Services Coordinator
- Knowledge, experience and understanding of assessments and using data to monitor student growth, inform instruction
- Good communication skills in writing and speaking with staff, students, and parents.
- Commitment to the mission and vision of McDonnell Area Catholic Schools

Responsibilities/Functions

1. Provide a small group or 1:1 remedial instruction for students who have been identified as having an educational disability. This could also mean teaching alternative middle school classes for English, Math, Science and Social Studies credit.
2. Develop data collection procedures for measuring progress on all ISP goals and objectives

3. Collect and analyze data on individual students and make instructional recommendations in conjunction with the Student Support Services Coordinator
4. Work collaboratively with teachers and other education staff to provide comprehensive services to students in the SNSP program
5. Document time and tasks devoted to the SNSP program
6. Prepare quarterly reports for parents for approval from the Student Support Services Coordinator
7. Develop and maintain a professional working relationship with public school case managers of students in the SNSP program
8. Create educational materials for students in the SNSP program
9. Share with respective teachers all accommodations and other support outlined on the students' ISP.
10. Administer formal and informal assessment benchmarks and probes
11. Attend and participate in the annual ISP and quarterly review meetings as appropriate
12. Maintain a clean, orderly learning space for all students
13. All other duties as assigned
